

A3 Con: Linking and Organizing Cards — Evolving

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Ideas with Luhmann's Method

Story Script (Introduction for Parents and Children): This final attachment card will teach children how to link their ideas together, just like Niklas Luhmann did. By organizing their cards and creating connections between them, children will understand how each part of their dream kindergarten fits together.

Step 1: Drawing the Cards

Tip:

• Draw a new set of cards. For example, you might draw the lunchroom, the art room, and the library. Each of these cards represents a different part of the kindergarten, but now we'll learn how to connect them.

Step 2: Linking the Cards

Tip:

• Use arrows, colors, or stickers to link your cards. For example, you could link the art room to the library because both places encourage creativity. Add arrows or lines connecting the two cards to thow how the ideas are related.
