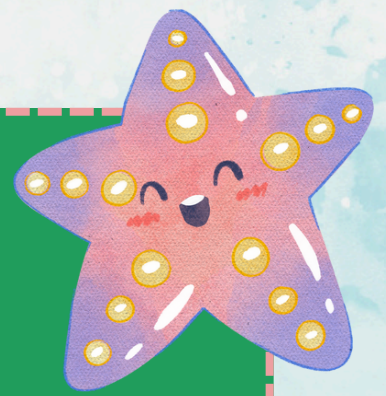


# T2.001
